Biography

Ana Miralles was born in Madrid in 1959. Following her degree in Fine Arts School, she began her career in comics and illustration in 1982, publishing her first story in the Spanish magazine Rambla. She then published in magazines Madriz, Cairo, Marca Acme, Blue Press, Marie-Claire Spain, Vogue Spain and Je Bouquine.

Her first black and white album, "El brillo de una Mirada" on Emilio Ruiz's screenplay, was published in black and white in 1990 by Editions La General.

In 1991, the first volume of the trilogy of Eva Medusa "You the venom", on scenario of Antonio Segura appears at Glénat. The other titles: "You, the desire" and "You, love" come out in 1993 and 1994. This series has also been marketed in Spain, Germany, the Netherlands and the USA.

With the screenwriter Emilio Ruiz, she adapted in comics the novel by Juan Eslava Galan, "In search of the unicorn", a work rewarded in Spain, Portugal and Italy.

In 2001, she created "Djinn" with Jean Dufaux, her most popular series to date. The twelfth volume was released in 2014.

Having become famous especially for her subjects with erotic connotations, Ana Miralles became in June 2009 the first woman to win the "Gran Premio del Salón" at the Barcelona Comic Strip Festival.

A sensitive and prolific author, his work is divided into a multitude of illustrated books, postcards, covers of books and magazines, exhibitions, collective collections, advertisements and serigraphs.
