Biography

Georges Stein specialised in Paris views and he successfully portrayed the Belle époque atmosphere in his paintings. He painted the symbolic places of the capital : the Madeleine, les Champs-élysées, la Tour Saint-Jacques, l'île de la Cité, and especially the grand boulevards. Georges Stein also depicted the 1900s society through different views of various districts of Nice and London. He exhibited at the French Artists Society and the Carnavalet Museum has some of his work.
